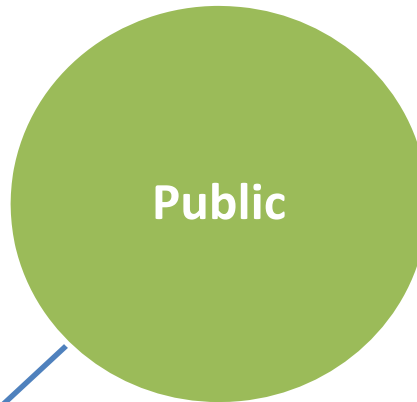
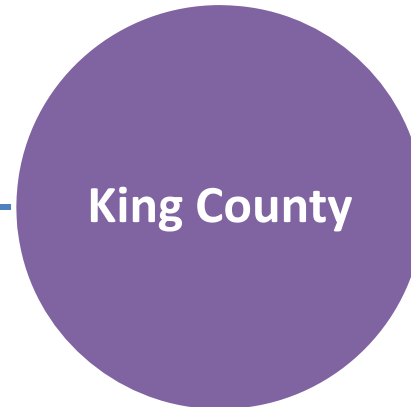


KING COUNTY FERRY DISTRICT

- The King County Ferry District (KCFD) is a special-purpose government formed to provide a transportation alternative through passenger-only ferry service.
- The KCFD Board of Supervisors is composed of the members of the King County Council.



- KCFD is accountable to the public (taxpayers, riders, communities, businesses and others).
- KCFD strives to deliver excellent service, inform the public, demonstrate exemplary business practices, exhibit sustainable environmental practices, and deliver projects on time and on budget.



- KCFD contracts with King County to provide both passenger-only ferry and connecting shuttle services on the West Seattle and Vashon routes.
- The Department of Transportation – Marine Division oversees operations and maintenance of service, and contracts with vessel operators.



- KCFD contracts with Seattle Parks and Recreation for use of the Seacrest Park dock.
